Wind Ensemble Auditions take place in the first week of each Quarter as needed. Every musician must pass a yearly audition to be a member of the Wind Ensemble. These auditions are given in a calm atmosphere to hopefully allow for relaxed performances.

All auditioning musicians should plan on playing a piece of music which they have prepared. For best audition results, please present a piece written for your instrument, instead of a popular song or melody. This piece will show how you perform with familiar material. If you don't have prepared music, you will be asked to play some scales. This audition will give an idea of your playing level. All auditioning musicians will be asked to sight read. The entire audition process takes about 10 minutes.
